6. I will have taken IELTS by this time in October. (future perfect tense)
7. The president will have finished his term in 2025. (future perfect tense)
8. The ship had arrived when the security searched our belongings. (past perfect tense)
9. Her father has been ill for three years. (present perfect tense)
10. I have been in this company since 2016. (present perfect tense)
